Girl Students are exempted from the tuition fee by the Government of Gujarat. We have also provided Rs.120000/-(One Lac Twenty Thousand) to the Meritorious SC/ST/OBC and Minority students under

Colleges with relatively higher proportion of SC/ST/OBC and Minority Students under Merged Scheme of UGC.

One lecture is arranged on "School Management" on 18th September, 2011 by an alumnus named Mr.Gadhesariya Harjivan R. who is a director at Gajera Educational Sankul, Amreli.

There were various sports competitions arranged in the institute. Among them, one was **Kabaddi** which was arranged on 10th & 11th August, 2011 for boys and Girls. There were Six teams of boys and Four teams of girls participated. F.Y.B.Com. team was the Winner in Boys and B.A. Team was the winner in Girls.

District Level **Saptdhara Competition** was held at Junagadh on 6th & 7th September, 2011. There were twelve students participated in Kabaddi and twelve students in Tug of War (Rassa Khench) competition. Our Kabaddi team stood Third at District Level and in Tug of War, our team stood Second at District Level.

Second competition was **Volleyball** which was arranged on 9th September, 2011 for boys and 10th September, 2011 for Girls. There were Six Teams of boys and Four Teams of girls took part in the competition. T.Y.B.A. was the winner in boys and B.Com. Team was the winner in girls.

Athletics event was arranged on 15th & 16th December, 2011. There were 135 boys and girls participated.

Cricket (Boys) was arranged on 5th & 6th January, 2012. There were six teams participated. S.Y.B.Com. team was the Champion.

Girnar Arohan Avarohan Competition took place at Junagadh in January, 2012. There were ten boys and ten girls participated.

Babariya Sujeet J. got First Rank in 'Colage' Competition in the Youth Festival organized by Saurashtra University and held at Amreli on 30th September, 2011. Among them, **111** cleared A1 level and **18** Students have cleared A2 and **One** student cleared B1 level ESOL examination conducted by Government of Gujarat. This course is affiliated to Cambridge University (U.K.). **Six** awards were given to those students who achieved First, Second and Third ranks in Arts and Commerce Programmes in T.Y.B.A. and B.Com.
